party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said Party of the first part for and  
in Consideration of the sum of One Dollar lawful Money of the United States  
to her in hand paid by the said Party of the second part, the receipt whereof  
is hereby Confessed and Acknowledged had given granted bargained sold  
remised released and quit claimed and by these presents as give Grant  
bargain sell remise release and quit claim unto the said Party of the  
second part And to her heirs and assigns forever.

All that Certain parcel of Land Situate in the Town of Byron in said  
County of Fond du Lac described as follows to wit: Commencing at the  
South West-Corner of the west half of the North West Quarter of Section  
Thirty two (32) thence running East Twelve  $\frac{5}{8}$  rods thence North Twelve  $\frac{5}{8}$   
rods thence West-Twelve  $\frac{5}{8}$  rods thence South to the place of Beginning  
Containing One Acre of Land -

To have and to hold the same together with  
all and Singular the Appurtenances and privileges therunto belonging or in  
anywise therunto appertaining, and all the Estate right title interest and  
Claim whatsoever of the said Party of the first part either in Law or Equity  
to the Only proper use benefit and behoof of said Party of the second part
