

FOURTH — That the title to said property and the right of possession thereto shall be and remain in said Hevi-Duty Electric Company, seller, until said sum of Twenty Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars and interest shall be fully paid.

FIFTH — That in case of default in any of the payments of the principal or interest when due as above specified, the said Hevi-Duty Electric Company, seller, shall thereupon forthwith have the right to declare the whole sum still unpaid due and payable without notice to the buyer, or to declare this agreement at an end, and with or without notice, to take immediate possession of said above described property, and in such case, the said property, as well as all payments of principal and interest which have been made hereon, shall belong to and be retained by said Hevi-Duty Electric Company, seller, for the use of the aforesaid property, and as stipulated damages for non-performance of this agreement on the part of said W.
