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Portland Division was advised on 4/25/72 by correction officials, Multnomah County Rocky Butte Jail, Portland, Oregon, that subjects had attempted to escape by sawing a hole in a cell ceiling on 4/23/72. Jail officials were made aware that FBI should be immediately notified of an escape attempt involving Federal prisoners. Correction officials advised that their department would immediately contact the FBI regarding such matters as they have done in the past when an actual escape occurs.

Synopsis:

On 4/25/72, Multnomah County Rocky Butte Jail official advised that subjects attempted to escape on 4/23/72 by sawing through a cell ceiling. Subjects denied involvement. No saw blades located by custodial officers in cell or on subjects after extensive search. On 4/25/72, AUSA, Portland, Oregon, declined prosecution due to lack of prosecutive merit. ESCAPE RISK.

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DETAILS

This investigation was predicated upon receipt of information from [redacted] Multnomah County Rocky Butte Jail, Portland, Oregon, on April 25, 1972, that three Federal prisoners and one State prisoner, all lodged at Rocky Butte Jail had attempted to escape on April 23, 1972, by sawing a hole through the cell ceiling. Attempt was thwarted.

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[redacted], Multnomah County Rocky Butte Jail, Portland, Oregon, telephone [redacted] advised that on April 23, 1972, at approximately 2:00 P.M., while a corrections officer was conducting a routine inspection of B Block, observed a cut place in the ceiling of cell #10, occupied by [redacted] JACK LEE WEBSTER, [redacted]

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[redacted] The cut was approximately two feet in length and varied in depth in the ceiling. [redacted] stated that approximately five days prior to this incident, these individuals had occupied a cell block in which four or five cells had been marked up by using some type of saw blade. The blade(s) were never found. He stated that due to this occurrence, these individuals were put in an unmarked cell (#10, B Block).

[redacted] continued that a thorough search was conducted of the cell but that no cutting object or saw blade was found. Further, a thorough search of the individuals did not uncover any saw blade.

[redacted] continued that all individuals involved were questioned concerning their knowledge of the cut in the ceiling and of the blades used in making the cut. These individuals denied any knowledge of any saw blades and denied making the cut in the cell ceiling.

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All four of the individuals were placed in separate cells to improve the security of the jail.

[redacted] stated that [redacted] WEBSTER, and [redacted] are all Federal prisoners, and that [redacted] is currently confined on a State charge.





On April 25, 1972, SA [redacted] Portland, Oregon, advised U.S. Marshal [redacted] Portland, of the attempted escape involving the subjects. [redacted] advised that subject [redacted] subsequent to his appearance at a jury trial, Portland, Oregon, on April 25, 1972, is now being confined at the Marion County Jail, Eugene, Oregon.

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On April 25, 1972, the facts of this matter were presented to Assistant U.S. Attorney (AUSA) [redacted] [redacted] Portland, Oregon. [redacted] declined prosecution in this matter because of lack of prosecutive merit. Due to discussion with AUSA and his declination, subjects in this matter were not interviewed.

SUBJECTS [redacted], WEBSTER, AND [redacted] SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ESCAPE RISKS SINCE THEY ATTEMPTED TO ESCAPE MULTNOMAH COUNTY ROCKY BUTTE JAIL, PORTLAND, OREGON.

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
